My name is Nikita Billier, student in Dual Master Degree between University College London and Higher School of Economics (IMESS Programme). I am studying Politics and Security at UCL and one of the pathways of my specialization is immigration. ISPR RAS gave me the opportunity to meet many migrations specialists and experts on demographic issues.
