Requirements for the materials content and execution

Requirements	Characteristics
Language for the conference materials publication	English and Russian
Total amount of materials (including the title, abstract, key words, text, references)	10-12 thousand characters with spaces (including references) font TNR, 14 size regular spacing between letters, line spacing 1.5; margins - 2 cm from all sides
Abstract and Key words	The abstract should contain 7-10 sentences and include a brief description of the relevance, research problems, a brief description of the research methodology and results. Don't use italics, underline, etc. The text should be presented in one paragraph Citation is not allowed Abbreviations should be decoded Immediately after the abstract, the key words must be presented, which can consist of individual words and phrases. Italic or bold text should not be selected.
Requirements for the content of the article and its execution	After the keywords, you need to submit the text of the article itself. The text is divided into sections indicating their name in accordance with the structure of the article. The font size and the spacing between lines should be the same throughout the text. Paragraphs ("red line") should be set automatically, and not with the space bar. The presence of double or triple spaces is not permissible. At the first use of abbreviations it is obligatory to specify their decoding. Direct speech, quoting should be made using quotes from the English keyboard layout, for example, "... ..". DO NOT use the quotation marks in the format «.....».
Requirements for tables, figures and formulas	The text can contain tables, the labels to which should be shown above the table with a width equalization. The text in the tables: the interval is single, font 12 TNR. Figures and formulas should contain only Latin characters, English text. All formulas must be in the "Microsoft Equation" macro (Word program). Graphic drawings should be of good quality in black and white format. If there are inscriptions, then the text should be displayed clearly. The number of tables and figures - no more than 3. Bulky tables are not allowed.
Requirements for the sources used in the article	When borrowing material from other sources, a reference to these sources is obligatory. References to scientific articles from Russian and foreign peer-reviewed journals are mandatory.
References and the list of references style	- References in the text are to be shown in square brackets. - Sources are indicated in the order of quoting in the text. - All sources from the list of bibliography should be referenced in the text.
Information about the author(s)	After the title of the scientific article the following items are indicated: - Full name of the author - first the name, then the patronymic, after it - the surname - Ivan Ivanovich Ivanov; - e-mail and contact phone for communication; - position and place of work.
